The Disciple of Christ: Growing & Fruitful 2 Peter 1:3-8 Part Z

- God has given us everything we need to have a spiritual life of power, godliness, and fruitfulness. vs. 3
- "And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power." Colossians 2:10
- As we learn to grow and walk in total faith in Jesus Christ, spiritual fruit is the natural outgrowth. Let's examine the fruit of a growing disciple of Jesus Christ.
- 1. First fruit: virtue. vs. 5
- 2. Second fruit: knowledge. vs. 5
- 3. Third fruit: temperance. vs. 6
 - Temperance carries the idea of restraint.
 - Temperance is when your *fleshly* appetite is restrained and controlled.
 - Temperance is a fruit of the Spirit. Galatians 5:23
 - Trying harder will not bring temperance. Temperance is found in *trusting* Christ to live through you.

"This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh." **Galatians 5:16**

- 4. Fourth fruit: patience. vs. 6
 - "Patience" carries the idea of "enduring when circumstances are difficult."

- "So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure."
 2 Thessalonians 1:4
- "Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience." James 5:10
- "...but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God." 1 Peter 2:20b
- What an example of patience Christ showed!
- "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:2
- This same Jesus *lives* in us!
- We bear the fruit of His patience as we surrender to Christ in us.
- "Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness."
 Colossians 1:11

Are you a growing and fruitful disciple of Jesus Christ?

- "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen." 2 Peter 3:18
- Your greatest need is simply to grow in the grace and knowledge of your relationship with Christ.
