- 1 Samuel 2:12 is very telling. Eli's sons "*knew not the Lord.*"
- Whose fault was this?
- "*And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.*" **Ephesians 6:4**
- Parents, you must provide the \_\_\_\_\_ your children need to know the Lord, and to love and serve the Lord.
- "*And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.*" **2 Timothy 3:15**

**Second, refuse the temptation to become a \_\_\_\_\_ parent.**
