- According to Titus 2:9-10, when you display a certain conduct while working, you beautify what you believe about Jesus Christ and the Word of God.
- When you are working, how do you beautify your beliefs?

**First, always demonstrate proper**

---

- *“Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ.”* **Ephesians 6:5**

**Second, exhibit complete**

---

- Your daily life should reflect Who lives inside of you.
- *“Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.”* **Romans 12:17**
- *“Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men.”*  
**2 Corinthians 8:21**

- Daniel is an example for us. He knew he represented God everywhere and in everything he did. Daniel 6:4, 20

**Third, show \_\_\_\_\_ for your work.**

- *“And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men.”*  
**Colossians 3:23**

- *“With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men.”* **Ephesians 6:7**

**Fourth, display a good \_\_\_\_\_ at all times.**

- *“Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.”*  
**Daniel 6:3**
