



- As we look at the Good Samaritan, we see Jesus. How do we see Jesus?

**First, Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ where we were.**

- There was no way for the Samaritan to save this wounded man from a distance. Notice that it says, *“He came where he was.” vs. 33-34*
- Jesus knew He couldn’t do what was necessary to save us from a distance, so He came right where we were.
- *“And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.”*  
**John 1:14**
- *“In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.” 1 John 4:9*

**Second, Jesus was moved with \_\_\_\_\_ towards us.**

- Jesus will heal your \_\_\_\_\_ life and make you a new person.
- *“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”*  
**2 Corinthians 5:17**

### Third, Jesus took our \_\_\_\_\_ upon Himself.

- The Good Samaritan *“went to him and bound up his wounds.”*
- *“Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.” Isaiah 53:4-5*
- *“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.” 1 Peter 2:24*
- 1 John 3:16 exclaims, *“Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us...”*

### Fourth, Jesus paid the entire \_\_\_\_\_ to save us.

- *“For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.” Romans 5:6*
- *“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Romans 6:23*

### Fifth, Jesus will come \_\_\_\_\_ for us.

- *“For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.”*  
**1 Thessalonians 4:16-17**
