## BEING SET FREE FROM THE ENEMY WITHIN

ROMANS 6

- If a believer in Christ is to be defeated and destroyed, it will happen by the enemy \_\_\_\_\_ us. The Bible calls it "the flesh."
- Paul describes this battle.
- "For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would."
   Galatians 5:17
- But how can we be set free?

First, understand your \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ. vs. 3-4, 6, 22

 The control and power of indwelling sin has been destroyed.

Second, live in the \_\_\_\_\_ of your union with Christ, vs. 11

 God knows you have freedom from indwelling sin, but you must live in that reality every day. You must count it \_\_\_\_\_ for you!

Third, \_\_\_\_\_ to the truth of God. vs. 13, 17, 19

- When faced with fleshly temptations, we have a clear choice: "Will I deny God and say "No" to Him or will I deny self?" vs. 16-17
- How do sinful, fleshly habits occur? One \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ at a time.

Fourth, \_\_\_\_\_ the Spirit, not the flesh. vs. 19, 22

- "And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked: (For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds.)" 2 Peter 2:7-8
- "Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul." 1 Peter 2:11
- "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting." Galatians 6:7-8
- "But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof."
   Romans 13:14

If you starve the flesh and consistently feed the spirit, you will be set from the enemy within.
