- Jesus taught that there is a harvest to reach.  
vs. 36-38
- But God needs laborers. God is committed to working through people.
- *“I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.” 1 Corinthians 3:6-7*
- The Pharisees were self-absorbed and missed the harvest.
- We cannot afford to let this happen.

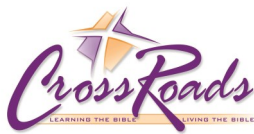
- Matthew was a tax collector who left all and followed Christ (vs. 9). Tax collectors were known as a “sick” group.

- *“And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins.”* **Ephesians 2:1**
