- Jesus Christ loved this man that nobody else loved.
- "Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more... Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God."

2 Corinthians 5:16, 20

Who will stand in Satan's way? Only Spirit-filled believers who decide to love the unlovable and show them love. Third, because Christ's ____ can revolutionize a person's life. After Jesus showed this disturbed man love and compassion, notice what the Bible says in verse 15: Sitting – this man's heart that was filled with unrest was now at peace. Clothed – this man outwardly looked different. In his right _____ – this man became completely rational. Jesus saw beyond what this man was to what he
