- Sharing your testimony with others can be a powerful way to share the gospel of Christ with others.
- Every believer can share their testimony with others. How?

First, tell them about your life B.C. (_____ Christ).

- Try to find elements of your _____ that others can identify with and relate to.
- As you share with them your previous lost condition, you can use this as a tool to reiterate Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23.
- *“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.”* **Romans 3:23**
- *“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”* **Romans 6:23**

Second, _____ them to Jesus.

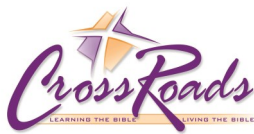
- Share with them Romans 5:8.
- *“But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8*
- Always make clear who Christ is and what He has done. Acts 26:23
- Explain to them how your life has taken on new _____ since accepting Christ.

Third, _____ God’s Word to do the work.

- *“For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” Romans 10:13*
- God’s Word is what draws sinners to Christ.
- *“So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.” Romans 10:17*

Fourth, expect God to _____ you.

- Sometimes sharing your testimony can lead a person to Christ; other times it will begin to create a thirst and hunger in them to know _____ about Christ.
- When you share your testimony and God’s truth, it is never in vain. God will _____ use it.
