**First, always begin with praise. vs. 9**

- "*But my God shall supply all your **need** according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*" **Philippians 4:19**

- "*And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.*"  
**1 Timothy 6:8**

- "*But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.*" **1 Timothy 6:9**

- We have many other needs besides those in the physical realm.
- What do you need to see God do in your life? How do you want to see God work in a particular situation? Prayer gets God \_\_\_\_\_.
- *“Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.”* **Philippians 4:6**
- One of the greatest challenges we have as human beings is to distinguish what our true needs are.
- So, God has given us a \_\_\_\_\_ every time we pray.
- *“Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.”* **Romans 8:26**
