Angels are created, beings.	
1.	Angels were created by God (Psalm 148:2-5), probably on day two of creation when God created the heavens. • "Thou, even thou, art LORD alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee." Nehemiah 9:6
2.	 Why were the angels created? Ultimately, they were created to glorify Jesus Christ, their Creator. "For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him." Colossians 1:16
3.	Angels are not glorified beings.

5.	Angels are invisible,beings. Hebrews 1:14; cf. Ephesians 6:12
