## The Most Crucial Division in the Bible (Part 2)

## This interruption in the prophetic program is the great mystery that was kept secret since the world began.

- God set Israel aside (temporarily) and offered salvation to all of His enemies in the entire world through \_\_\_\_\_\_ in Christ's shed blood. Colossians 1:20-21; Ephesians 2:11-13
