“REDEMPTION”**

**First, what does the word redemption mean?**

- It is to release a captive by paying a \_\_\_\_\_.

**Second, why do I need redemption?**

- You and I need redemption because we are in the worst kind of captivity.
- We are captives in the family of \_\_\_\_\_. Ephesians 2:2-3
- We desperately need redemption. Without it we are doomed.

**Third, who has paid for my redemption?**

- Jesus Christ kept the law, therefore the law could not justly demand His death.
- But do you know what He did? He willingly gave His life and bore the \_\_\_\_\_ of the law (death).
- *“Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree.” Galatians 3:13*
- Christ \_\_\_\_\_ our ransom!

- *“Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus.”* **Romans 3:24**
- Redemption is found in a \_\_\_\_\_ - Jesus Christ.
- *“Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things...  
But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.”* **1 Peter 1:18-19**

#### **Fourth, how do I apply redemption to my life?**

- It is a gift of God's \_\_\_\_\_, and can only be received by faith.
- Once you are redeemed, you become a child of God and part of His \_\_\_\_\_.
- *“But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law,  
To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.”* **Galatians 4:4-5**
