1.	Hosea prophesied that God would return in judgment and take away all of Israel's
	that they had prepared for Baal. vs. 8-9, 11-13;
	Ezekiel 16:28-39
2.	When everything looks dark and without hope, suddenly a ray of hope shines, and
	in verses 14-23 we have one of the greatest passages in Scripture concerning the
	future blessing God has in store for the nation of Israel.
3.	God gives Israel twelve "I wills" in verses 15-23. These are divine promises from
	the mouth of God to the nation of Israel.
4.	God will once again give Israel their, never to be uprooted again.
