## First, parents must have a \_\_\_\_\_ and goal.

- "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it." **Proverbs 22:6**
- *"Train"* indicates that you, as a parent, have an active and positive goal.

## Second, parents must apply consistent

- What are ways that we know our children are partaking in folly or foolishness?
  - ⇒ They are deceitful and \_\_\_\_\_. Proverbs 14:8

- ⇒ They lack \_\_\_\_\_-control, exhibiting angry outbursts. Proverbs 14:17, 29
  ⇒ They lack good decision making and won't to instruction. Proverbs 16:21-22
  - ⇒ They exhibit an arrogant, know-it-all attitude. Proverbs 18:12-13
  - ⇒ They cannot control their \_\_\_\_\_. Proverbs 15:2, 14
- If children are going to bring joy to our lives, they must be corrected when they act foolishly.

Third, parents must replace foolishness with \_\_\_\_\_. 29:15, 15:20-21

## Fourth, parents must provide godly

 "The words of king Lemuel, the prophecy that his mother taught him." Proverbs 31:1
