## Bible Study Series: The Book of Galatians Chapter 5

## Verse 4

- A. There is a phrase in this verse that many have taken out of context and corrupted the true meaning. It is the phrase "fallen from grace."
- B. It is important to understand that there are two kinds of grace discussed in the dispensation of grace.
  - There is grace that \_\_\_\_\_. Ephesians 2:8; Romans 5:21
  - There is grace that we are to \_\_\_\_\_ by after we are saved.
    1 Corinthians 15:10; 2 Corinthians 1:12, 9:8, 12:9; 2 Timothy 2:1;
    1 Peter 4:10, 5:12; 2 Peter 3:18
- C. From the context, it is clear that Paul is discussing the latter. This verse has nothing to do with \_\_\_\_\_\_ grace.
- D. They had fallen, not from a **position** of grace, but from a \_\_\_\_\_\_ of grace, and traded it for a life of bondage under the law.
- E. This is a struggle for so many Christians after they are saved. Instead of \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the grace of Christ to live through them, they

struggle to meet the church's or other people's expectations.

- Living by \_\_\_\_\_ means that we are depending totally on Christ's resources.
- Living by \_\_\_\_\_ means that we are depending on our own fleshly resources.
