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•	Religion says, "You're not enough to approach God
	in worship. You must perform our mystical rites and rituals. You
	must go through our religious leaders, or through dead saints, or
	through angels to approach God."
	This is a false humility, and leads people to get wrapped up in
	seeking angelic experiences, and mystical, supernatural
	experiences.
	False humility says, "I'm not good enough to approach God, so
	I'll start with one of His angels." There is mediator
	between God and men - Jesus Christ. 1 Timothy 2:5
