•	Singles, you can give yourself wholly and unreservedly to the Lord. Do not
	think, "I will serve the Lord when I get married." is the time. You
	can have your biggest for the cause of Christ right now!
Th	ne single life is a life of vs. 6-7, 25
•	Paul teaches that the single life is a good life, but it isn't for everybody, and you
	have liberty in Christ to make that for yourself.
