There are distinct divisions in the Bible that must be distinguished.
These divisions indicate a way in which God is dealing with
mankind, different from the previous time period.
These divisions are referred to as dispensations.

Most doctrine today is derived from taking Scriptures
out of their context.
Rightly dividing the Word of God means placing Scripture in
