- We are here to celebrate the greatest event in history - the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

*"But you are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. ... But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you."* **Romans 8:9, 11**

- I can have the Spirit of Christ living \_\_\_\_ me!
- When you have a relationship with Christ, something radical happens at your innermost being.
- Christ's resurrection means that I have (verse 22):

**Power to remove \_\_\_\_\_ out of my life.**

*"And that he (Christ) died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. ... Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."* **2 Corinthians 5:15, 17**

## Power to replace it with \_\_\_\_\_ things.

- Jesus Christ gives you the power to replace bad things with healthy and productive things.
  - Righteousness — Doing the \_\_\_\_\_ thing.
  - Faith — Everybody exercises faith in something. Faith (in the Bible) is simply putting your trust and confidence in the \_\_\_\_\_ thing.
  - Charity (love) — Love is \_\_\_\_\_. You follow love as you follow Christ.
  - Peace — You follow things that make for peace in your life.

## Power to \_\_\_\_\_ to God every day.

- Christ represents you before the Father and ensures that your prayers get through!

*“For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.” 1 Timothy 2:5*

- Power to talk to God means divine power for your daily living.

*“For the wages of sin is death; but the \_\_\_\_\_ of God is eternal \_\_\_\_\_ through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Romans 6:23*
