- The word "testimony" means "evidence given."
- He is referring to the fact of the overwhelming evidence of Christ's resurrection from the dead and the fact that He is

- Paul is reminding Timothy, "Don't be ashamed of these facts.
  Your faith and trust are in Him for good reason; so don't be ashamed of it."
- Living a life of purpose means living a life that is consistent with \_\_\_\_\_ you are.
- "That if you shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved... For the scripture says, Whosoever believes on him shall not be ashamed."

You were not created in Christ to be ashamed and afraid. You were created in Christ to have and influence
