1. Be _____ in the grace of Christ. Vs. 1

"I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me."

Philippians 4:13

"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."

Galatians 2:20

- This teaches us that not only are we **saved** by grace, but we _____ by grace **after** we are saved.
- Being strong in His grace is first and foremost having the right mindset. Every day:
 - You realize how much you _____ Christ and His strength.
 - You are praying and trusting Him to _____ in and through you.

- You are doing what Christ wants because you _____ Him, not because you feel guilty or ashamed if you don't.

2. Pass your _____ along. Vs. 2

- The word "commit" means "to deposit." Paul is encouraging Timothy to pass the truth along, invest in others, make a deposit in them.
- When you learn something about God, Jesus, the Bible, or your walk with Christ – don't keep that knowledge to yourself! _____ it with someone! Pass it along!
- This is going to give your life true impact, **beyond** your lifetime.
