- *“For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.”* **1 Corinthians 15:21**

- *“In him (Christ) was life; and the life was the light of men.”* **John 1:4**
- *“Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believes in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live.”* **John 11:25**
- *“Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by me.”* **John 14:6**
