- Try to find elements of your _____ that they can identify with and relate to.
- Explain to them Romans 3:23.

Second, explain what happened _____ you were saved. vs. 6-16

- Make clear who Christ is and what He has done.

- Explain to them your _____ to Christ when you were saved.
- Tell them of the role that others played in your salvation.

**Third, share what God has done in your life
_____ your salvation. vs. 17-21**

- In a few words, make sure they understand what Christ has meant to you and your family since the time of your salvation.

**Fourth, refuse to allow _____ reaction to
squelch your witness. vs. 22-30**

- When you give your testimony to others, be prepared for one of several responses:
- You may be interrupted and not allowed to finish.
- You may be _____ or resented.
