### **Introduction:**

- According to Titus 2:9-10, when you display a certain conduct while working, you beautify what you believe about Jesus Christ and the Word of God.
- When you are working, how do you beautify your beliefs?

### **By showing proper \_\_\_\_\_ for those in authority. vs. 9**

- *“Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ.”* **Ephesians 6:5**

### **By exhibiting complete \_\_\_\_\_ in everything you do. vs. 10**

- Your daily life should reflect who lives \_\_\_\_\_ of you.
- *“Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.”* **Romans 12:17**
- *“Providing for honest things, not only in the sight of the Lord, but also in the sight of men.”* **2 Corinthians 8:21**
- Daniel is an example for us. He knew he represented God everywhere and in everything he did. Daniel 6:4, 20

By demonstrating a \_\_\_\_\_ for your work. vs. 9

- *“With good will doing service, **as to the Lord**, and not to men.”*  
Ephesians 6:7
