- We can end up in so much trouble, stranded and shipwrecked spiritually.

•	God's Word is what grows our faith (confidence) in God, which, in turn, instructs our conscience and keeps it
•	The word "shipwreck" aptly describes the person whose conscience has been defiled and seared. Titus 1:15-16
Thi	rd, by dividing God's Word
•	Paul names two men that had become spiritually shipwrecked.
•	Their false teaching revolved around the issue of the resurrection of the saints. They were teaching it had already happened.
•	Their wrong division of the resurrection would then lead to a host of other teachings.
•	We must follow God's prescribed method of how to study the Bible – rightly dividing the Word of truth.
•	If not, we can end up getting sucked into false doctrine and end up spiritually shipwrecked.
•	These men in our text were not good soldiers. They had gone AWOL.
•	God desires from His children.
