- There is one major roadblock that keeps us from telling others about Jesus Christ – _____!
- How do we overcome our fears and talk to other people about Jesus Christ?
- There are three action steps that we can take in order to effectively talk to others about Christ.

First, you must _____ yourself to speak for Christ.

- If we don't prepare ourselves to speak for Christ, we will never do it.
- Paul didn't immediately begin witnessing to others about Christ. Paul received _____ and instruction. vs. 19
- After this training, what did Paul do? He began to speak out for Christ. vs. 20, 22
- *"Let your speech be alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man."*
Colossians 4:6
- *"But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear."*
1 Peter 3:15

Second, you must _____ and seize opportunities to speak for Christ.

- You can't expect a lost person to freely talk about Jesus Christ and _____ topics.
- You must find ways to turn the conversation toward Christ and open the discussion.
- *"So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also. For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek."* **Romans 1:15-16**

Third, you must pray to God for _____ to speak for Christ.

- *"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints; And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel, For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak."* **Ephesians 6:18-20**
