- If you are in Christ, you are an ambassador for Christ.
   2 Corinthians 5:17-20
- The question is, "How are you doing representing the King of heaven on earth?"
- How can you be an effective ambassador for Christ to this world?

## First, understand clearly your \_\_\_\_\_ as an ambassador.

- Jesus Christ is not here on this earth any longer. Today, Christ is speaking His \_\_\_\_\_ through His appointed ambassadors.
- Do you know people that do not know Christ as their Savior? You are Christ's representative to them.
- "For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light." **Ephesians 5:8**
- "That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world."
   Philippians 2:15

Second, understand clearly your as an ambassador.
<ul> <li>To "reconcile" simply means to " two parties to union or agreement after being previously alienated."</li> <li>2 Corinthians 5:18-19</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>"And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled."</li> <li>Colossians 1:21</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>You can have an eternal position of reconciliation with the God of heaven!</li> </ul>
Third, understand clearly your as an ambassador.
<ul> <li>"For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing." 1 Thessalonians 1:8</li> </ul>
Fourth, understand clearly your as an ambassador.
<ul> <li>Our mission is to take the good news of Christ to them.</li> <li>They have a free to accept or reject the message.</li> </ul>
