⇒ First, Paul exhibited a desire to God's Word. vs. 22

 The Bible is the Christian's spiritual It feeds our spirit and gives us spiritual strength.
 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby." 1 Peter 2:2

⇒ Third, Paul desired to be with other vs. 19, 26, 28
