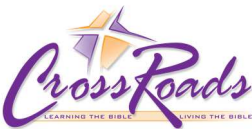

- "*...great is the mystery of godliness...*"
 - ⇒ God, in His infinite wisdom and power, has established a means by which sinners can be forgiven, restored, and reconciled back to God.
