2.	The apostle Paul strongly admonishes the church in Ephesians 4:1-3 to
	actively seek to promote peace in their relationships with one another.
3.	Harmonious relationships God, but unresolved conflict
	grieves the Spirit of God. Ephesians 4:29-31
4.	Like everything else, relationships will naturally and
	deteriorate unless every effort is made to maintain and build them.
