Introduction

- Have you every wondered why God didn't take you to heaven after you trusted Christ and entered His family? It is because God has a <u>work</u> for you to do.
- 2. God has a ministry for you! Ministry is giving to and serving <u>others.</u>

First, every believer is <u>saved</u> to serve. vs. 1-2

Second, every believer is gifted to serve. vs. 3-8

- When God places you in the body of the church, He expects you to <u>function</u>, not vegetate.
- 2. Because God expects you to function as a contributing member of the body, God has gifted you to serve or minister. vs. 6
- The purpose of your gifts is to be a <u>blessing</u> to others. 1 Corinthians 14:12;
 1 Peter 4:10
- 4. The effectiveness of our church depends on the number of people who are involved in meaningful ministry.
- God gifts certain people in the church with teaching and leadership gifts so that they can <u>grow</u> and mature the saints and prepare **them** for ministry.
 Ephesians 4:11-16
