Fir	st, every believer is to serve. vs. 1-2			
1.	These people had experienced God's mercy and forgiveness. Paul said, "Is it not			
	reasonable that you should serve this One who saved you?"			
2.	If you have been saved by His mercy, you don't serve Him out of guilt, shame, or			
	fear. You serve Him out of gratitude because you to!			
3.	Paul said that as we minister for God, it is a sacrifice. Christ died for			
	us so we could unto Him.			
	"And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto			
	themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again."

1.	God likens the church to a human body. vs. 4-5			
	You have different members of your body with different functions, but they			
	have a function.			

2.	When God places you in the body of the church, He expects you to,			
	not vegetate.			
3.	Because God expects you to function as a contributing member of the body, God			
	has you to serve or minister. vs. 6			
4.	The purpose of your gifts is to be a to others. 1 Corinthians 14:12:			
	1 Peter 4:10			
5.	The effectiveness of our church depends on the number of people who are			
	in meaningful ministry.
