

# God's Law of Sowing and Reaping

## Nahum 3

Pew Bible pg # 967

- *“Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.” Galatians 6:7-8*
- There are three vital aspects of God's law of sowing and reaping that every person must understand. We see them here in Nahum 3.

**First, you always reap \_\_\_\_\_ you sow.**

- Very simply put, what you \_\_\_\_\_, you will harvest.
- *“Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men.” Hosea 10:13*
- Our \_\_\_\_\_ have consequences.

**Second, you always reap \_\_\_\_\_ than you sow.**

- You sow a seed and reap a \_\_\_\_\_.

- God said of wicked Israel, *“For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind...”* **Hosea 8:7a**

**Third, you always reap \_\_\_\_\_ than you sow.**

- *“And let us not be weary in well doing: for in **due season** we shall reap, if we faint not.”* **Galatians 6:9**
- For years Nineveh had planted the seeds of wickedness, but thought harvest day would \_\_\_\_\_ come.
- But the day of \_\_\_\_\_ finally came.
- Remember, \_\_\_\_\_ day doesn't usually come right away.
- Because people are not judged immediately, they mistakenly think, “God doesn't \_\_\_\_\_,” or, “God doesn't \_\_\_\_\_.”
- *“Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.”* **Ecclesiastes 8:11**
- One day each and every person will stand before God and give account for their personal life. The day of \_\_\_\_\_ will come!
