Have You Received God's Gift? Romans 6:23

Introduction:

- 1. **Illustration:** H & R Block and Sims Family
- 2. Similarly, there is a gift that the God of this universe wants so much to give you.
 - Maybe He has tried to get you to take it before. Maybe, like the Sims family, you didn't understand, or you thought, "This is too good to be true."
 - For whatever reason, you didn't receive God's gift.
- 3. Just like H & R Block kept calling the Sims family, God is calling you again tonight, and He wants so much for you to receive His gift and it is much better than a million dollars from H & R Block.
- 4. It is so important that before you die, you receive God's gift, but you may be thinking, "What gift are talking about? God wants to give me a gift?"

What is the gift of God?

- 1. I remember, as a kid, looking at the gifts under the tree and wondering what they could possibly be. I would shake them, hold them up in the light, feel them, etc. It was a mystery.
- 2. The good news is this the gift of God is not a mystery. You don't have to wonder and muse about what God's gift is to you. It is written down in black and white.
- 3. Read **Romans 6:23** According to this verse, what is the gift of God? Eternal life!
 - How long is eternal life? It is forever. How would you like to live forever?
 - Does that sound good to you? It is the greatest gift I can think of. It is the gift of God. cf. Titus 1:2; 1 John 2:25
- 4. One thing is for sure: You can **never** earn a gift.
 - Notice, it does not say, "The wages of righteousness is eternal life."
 - This is exactly what so many people think. "If I 'm good enough, I'll earn eternal life in heaven." No you won't it is a gift!
- 5. That is why the Bible says that we are saved by God's grace. **Ephesians 2:8-9**
 - You can't earn grace it is something that is given freely.
- 6. So what is the gift of God? Eternal life.

Why is God offering this gift?

- 1. Imagine a person with a death sentence, and he or she receives a full pardon. That would be good news to that person, would it not?
- 2. Did you know that every person on this earth has a divine death sentence on them? Look again at **Romans 6:23**, "For the wages of sin is death..."
 - The word "wages" simply means "pay." When the Bible was written, the word "wages" signified the daily pay of a Roman soldier.
 - So every sinner has a pay coming and that pay is death.
- 3. The death in view here is not just physical death, because everyone is going to eventually die physically even Christians.
 - What this is referring to is what the Bible calls "the second death." Revelation 20:14-15

- This is eternal death, eternal separation from God. It is incurring the wrath of God for all eternity. **2 Thessalonians 1:9**
- It is the wages (the payment) of sin. All who sin must expect to be paid because God is a just and equitable God. Who is included in this? **Romans 3:23** All of us!
- 4. Eternal life is **not** connected to our actions. It is the gift of God. Eternal death **is** connected to our actions. It is wages that we have earned.
- 5. Why is God offering the gift of eternal life? Because we all have a death sentence on us.

How does the gift become yours?

- 1. Look at the end of verse 23. The gift of eternal life comes **through** Jesus Christ our Lord. (**cf. Romans 5:1**) This is what Christmas is all about it is about Jesus.
 - How are we made at peace with God? Through Jesus Christ.
- 2. When it comes to your eternal soul and where it will spend eternity, the issue is this, "What have you done with Jesus Christ?"
 - The issue is not if you were a good person, or kept the Ten Commandments, went to church, got baptized, or if your parents were Christians, etc.
 - Eternal life comes through Jesus Christ, and the question God will ask every person is, "Did you receive my Son as your Savior or reject Him?"
- 3. Christ **alone** has procured eternal life for you.
 - It is Christ that lived a perfect life and then died for your sins. Romans 5:8
 - It is Christ that defeated death and rose from the dead. Romans 4:25
 - Christ is synonymous with eternal life. 1 John 5:11-12
- 4. How does the gift become yours? Receive Jesus Christ. When you receive Christ into your heart and life, at that moment you have also received the gift of eternal life. **John 1:12**
- 5. Christmas is all about God's gift to this world Jesus! And Jesus **is** eternal life.
- 6. You can turn away Christ and spurn His love, but understand, eternal life cannot be secured any other way.
 - A person may merit hell, but a person can never merit heaven.
- 7. It is a free gift that comes to you when you receive Jesus Christ and believe on Him with all your heart.
