# "Paul the Pattern"

#### Introduction:

- The Bible says that Christ saved Saul of Tarsus, the chief of sinners, and set him forth as "a pattern" for other believers in this age of grace. 1 Timothy 1:16
- The apostle Paul was a sinner like everyone else, yet his life is said to be a
  pattern to those who believe on Christ.

## How is Paul a pattern to us today?

### Paul is our pattern in <u>salvation</u>.

- 1. Jesus Christ was the Son of God, therefore He had no need of salvation, but rather came to be our *Savior*.
- 2. But, Paul is a wonderful pattern for anyone who desires God's salvation.
  - 1 Timothy 1:13-16
  - Paul was a wicked, blasphemous **sinner**. vs. 13
  - Yet, because of the <u>grace</u> of our Lord, Paul was gloriously saved.
     vs. 14-15
  - Paul simply believed on Christ and received everlasting life. vs. 16
- 3. Anyone who is saved should be able to give the exact same testimony. The details may differ, but these three basic points must be present. Ephesians 2:1-5, 8-9

# Paul is our pattern in service.

- O How did Paul serve the Lord?
  - He served the Lord with <u>humility</u>. vs. 19a
  - He continued serving God even in the <u>hard</u> times. vs. 19b
  - He served the Lord by <u>witnessing</u> to others of Christ. vs. 20-21, 25-26
  - He served the Lord, regardless of personal <u>expense</u>. vs. 22-25
  - He served the Lord by studying the Word of God and possessing a steadfast <u>confidence</u> in God's Word. vs. 27-28, 32
