	David likens God's words to Do you realize how invaluable God's Word is?
	God's Word should be cherished as the most valuable possession that a believer holds. Why is this true?
First, because God's Word is totally vs. 6	
"Th	e words of the Lord are pure words."
	God's Word is perfectly and completely free from all mixtures, from all fraud and deceit. Psalm 19:8, 119:140
	"All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." 2 Timothy 3:16
	The word "inspiration" literally means that Godout the words of Scripture.
•	God Almighty has communicated with us!
Second, because God's Word is completely vs. 7a.	

"Thou shalt keep them, O Lord..."

 The word "keep" means "to hedge about (as with thorns), to guard, to" 		
 "for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name." Psalm 138:2 		
 Satan's main business is to God's Word. Jeremiah 23:36; 2 Corinthians 2:17 		
 Satan corrupts God's Word, but God's Word rightly divided is completely reliable. You can fully trust God's Word. 		
Third, because God's Word is eternally vs. 7b		
"thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever."		
 "For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled." Matthew 5:18 		
God gave His Word and He will it and see it all through to completion.		
 "For ever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven." Psalm 119:89 		
 "Concerning thy testimonies, I have known of old that thou has founded them for ever." Psalm 119:152
