Verse 18-19

- 1. When we "put on" Christ in our daily lives, what does it look like in our family relationships?
- Paul gets real practical and shows us in this passage. Paul isn't dealing with the **details** of marriage in this text, but he will deal with two issues that have the potential to rip apart any marriage:
 - A wife who ______ her husband, possessing a bossy spirit
 - A husband who possesses a _____ spirit, failing to appreciate his wife, and attempting to rule over his wife rather than love her

- The answer for both of these issues is for the husband and wife to be ______ in the knowledge of Christ (vs. 10), putting on Christ in their attitudes and actions (vs. 12-13).
- It is interesting that neither verse here in Colossians deals with the core roles of either spouse, but rather it deals with the godly ______ of each spouse to the other's roles.
- 5. A godly wife **responds** to her husband's role of leadership with an attitude of ______. vs. 18
 - Submission is not the result of a ______ dictatorship.
 - Submission means that the wife recognizes her husband's leadership and responds to him in a way that ______ him to lead.
