•	King David had been forced to flee into the wilderness, but now it was time for the King to return to the throne of his kingdom. vs. 15
•	In so many ways, David is a of the King of kings – Jesus Christ.
•	Are you ready for this King's return? Are you prepared?
•	How can we prepare to meet the King, Jesus Christ?
Firs	st, possess an attitude of and repentance.
•	As David returned, the first person that ran out to meet him was Shimei. He was the one that had previously cursed at David and threw stones at him. 16:13
•	Shimei deserved to die. But, because of his repentance, he was spared from and given life. vs. 18-23
•	Did you know, like Shimei, we deserve because we have offended the King, Jesus Christ?
•	"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23
•	"Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God." Romans 3:19
•	Like Shimei, we too can be from the wrath of the King. How?
•	"In whom [Christ] we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of" Colossians 1:14

 "And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him [Christ], having forgiven you trespasses." Colossians 2:13 		
Second, live in anticipation of His		
 Do you remember Mephibosheth? He was the crippled man that David showed mercy to. 9:7 		
 Mephibosheth was to the King and lived in anticipation of His return. vs. 24–30 		
 We should be looking for and to see our Savior. 		
 "Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing." 2 Timothy 4:8 		
Third, remember, your faithfulness will be		
 Another person that met David when he returned was an elderly man by the name of Barzillai. vs. 32; cf. 17:27-29 		
Barzillai is an example of a man who was a steward and continued to be faithful until his King returned.		
 Even on his deathbed, David remembered Barzillai's faithfulness and told Solomon to show kindness to his sons. 1 Kings 2:7 		
 Did you know our King, Jesus Christ, also notices and faithfulness? 		
 Maybe you have been discouraged lately. Maybe you have felt like quitting and throwing in the towel. Don't do it! Remember, your King could at any moment. 		
When we are tempted to, we must remember Christ.
