<ul> <li>As a local assembly of believers, how are we going to advance the gospel of Christ?</li> </ul>
First, by living a life that is with he gospel. vs. 27
Second, by working together as a s. 27
<ul> <li>The Bible teaches that when we trust Christ as our Savior, His very Spirit comes to live within us and we are made with the Lord.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>"But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit."</li> <li>1 Corinthians 6:17</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>"For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones." Ephesians 5:30</li> </ul>
• But did you know that God's Word teaches that we are also made one with each?
• "So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another." Romans 12:5
<ul> <li>"For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body"</li> <li>1 Corinthians 12:13a</li> </ul>

•	That position of oneness should be out and practiced in our everyday relationships with one another.
•	Satan's plan is to fracture the church with internal divisions.
•	Each person has to know his/her on the team and fulfill it to the glory of God and the advancement of the gospel.
Third, by displaying relentless vs. 28-30	
•	Paul says, "Don't be terrified of your adversaries." In other words, don't be afraid of them. Then Paul gives the church several encouragements:
	→ First, these battles demonstrate the reality of your vs. 28
	→ Second, it is a privilege to for Christ. vs. 29
	<ul> <li>"But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf." 1 Peter 4:15-16</li> </ul>
	→ Third, others are experiencing the suffering. vs. 30
	<ul> <li>"Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ." 2 Timothy 2:3</li> </ul>
