

# The Good News of Christmas

Luke 2:8-17

- When you think about celebrating Christmas, what thought should come into your mind immediately? “\_\_\_\_\_!”
- Without a doubt, one of the most mind-boggling events in history is the incarnation of Jesus Christ.
- Let’s examine some key questions about His birth and answer them from God’s Word.

## Was Christ’s birth in Bethlehem foretold? vs. 8-10

- Bethlehem was not an accident.
- Christ's birth was foretold centuries \_\_\_\_\_.
  - ⇒ The Savior would come from the seed of the \_\_\_\_\_. Genesis 3:15
  - ⇒ The nation He would come from would be Israel (Abraham’s seed). Genesis 12:3
  - ⇒ He would come from the tribe of \_\_\_\_\_. Genesis 49:10
  - ⇒ He would come from the family of \_\_\_\_\_. 2 Samuel 7:12-13
  - ⇒ He would come through the womb of a \_\_\_\_\_. Isaiah 7:14
  - ⇒ He would be born in the city of Bethlehem. Micah 5:2

## Second, what was the reason for Christ's birth?

### vs. 11-14

- He came to be our Savior and to save us from our \_\_\_\_\_.
- *"And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins."*  
**Matthew 1:21**
- *"...Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners."*  
**1 Timothy 1:15**
- *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."*  
**Romans 3:23**
- Jesus came to deliver us from the penalty of our sin and to set us free, so we can \_\_\_\_\_ with God eternally.
- *"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."* **Luke 19:10**

## Third, what should be our reaction to Christ's coming? vs. 15-17

- How did the shepherds react?
  - ⇒ They came with \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 15-16
    - ◇ The good news of Jesus isn't something you need to put off. You need to \_\_\_\_\_ with haste.
  - ⇒ They made it \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 17
    - ◇ It only makes sense that, when you find Christ, you want to \_\_\_\_\_ Him with others.
