- God's plan of salvation is not only to be trusted in and believed. It is also to be \_\_\_\_\_!
- You can be the channel that God uses to lead others to Jesus Christ. God desires to use you, Christian! How do we know this?

**First, because God has \_\_\_\_\_ the gospel to you – vs. 11**

- *"And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also."* **2 Timothy 2:2**
- God has made a deposit in us, and God expects a \_\_\_\_\_ on that investment.
- *"I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing... Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples."* **John 15:5, 8**
- There is somebody for you to impact and lead to Christ.

**Second, because God has \_\_\_\_\_ you to share it with others – vs. 12**

- When you trust Christ as your Savior, God's very Spirit comes to live and dwell inside of you and provide \_\_\_\_\_ for you to live your new life in Christ.
- *"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me."* **Philippians 4:13**

- Paul's conversion story is told at least six times in the New Testament.
- *"For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared."* **Titus 3:3-4**
- Christ changed Paul by His grace. vs. 14
- That grace is available to \_\_\_\_\_ through Christ's finished work. vs. 15
