First, God looks for a person with a _____ heart. vs. 5-7

Second, God looks for a person with aheart. vs. 8-11, 19-23
 David was faithful over a few sheep, and God chose him to be over an entire nation!
 God is not looking for people who are flashy; God is looking for people who are

• "And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit." Ephesians 5:18
