
The Rapture and the Boy Who Cried Wolf – Part 1

1.	Your Bible can be broken into two major divisions – mystery and prophecy.				
	The subject of has been revealed by God to his prophets since				
	the world began. Luke 1:68; Acts 3:21, 24; 2 Peter 1:21				
	In contrast to this, the of the body of Christ was kept				
	since the world began (Romans 16:25), and was not made known in other				
	ages (Ephesians 3:9), was from ages and from generations				
	(Colossians 1:26) until revealed to and through the apostle Paul				
	(Ephesians 3:3).

	right and should be reiterated. But to convince people that it has to occur soon				
	based on a wo	orld event is subjective and very spe	eculative.
