First, her sacrificial gift was absolutely . vs. 1-17

- Abigail had to offer her gift because of one man's sin -Nabal's! vs. 14
- "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23
- Jesus offered His sacrificial gift on the cross, not because of His own sins, but because of _____ sins.
- "Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father." Galatians 1:4
- Nabal would have surely died had it not been for Abigail's gift.
- Did you know our sin leads us to the same place?
- "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned." Romans 5:12

Second, her sacrificial gift was offered vs. 18-35	
•	"Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed." 1 Peter 2:24
•	Christ's sacrificial gift was offered for man.
•	"Who [Christ] gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time." 1 Timothy 2:6
Third, her sacrificial gift had to be vs. 36-39	
•	Christ's sacrifice was sufficient for you and me. How do we know? God raised up Christ from the!
•	"But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God." Hebrews 10:12
•	The sacrificial gift of Jesus has been offered on the cross, but it doesn't do us any good unless we humble our hearts and it.
•	"That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." Romans 10:9
