- 3. Why should Philemon forgive Onesimus? Why should **we** forgive those who have wronged us? The conclusion of this letter provides the answer.

1.	Did you know that when Christians harbor an unforgiving spirit, it robs us	
	of our peace? The reason why is because there is something instinctive	
	that tells us that this is and hypocritical.	
	When you accept a wealth of grace and then refuse to it	
	with others, you will lack peace. Ephesians 4:32	
2.	Forgiveness looses <b>you</b> and sets <b>you</b> ! Forgiveness is not an	
	easy thing, but once you do it, floods your mind and heart.
