- *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."* **Romans 3:23**

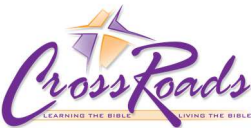
- *"But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities..." Isaiah 53:5a*
