## Colossians - Chapter 4 "Tychicus: An Unsung Hero" Colossians 4:7-8

## Verse 7-8

- 1. At the end of Paul's letters, we get to catch a glimpse of unsung heroes that were a blessing to Paul and to the cause of Christ.
- 2. In these verses, we learn of a man named Tychicus.
- 3. Tychicus is a great role model for the believer who endeavors to serve Christ. Paul tells us in these two verses what kind of man Tychicus was:
  - He was a \_\_\_\_\_ man "a beloved brother"
  - He was a \_\_\_\_\_ man "a faithful minister"
    - > They say the greatest \_\_\_\_\_\_ is dependability. 1 Corinthians 4:2
    - Tychicus was a faithful minister. Paul could \_\_\_\_\_\_ him. He had the utmost confidence in this man.
  - He was a \_\_\_\_\_man "fellowservant in the Lord"
    - Fellowservant one who serves the \_\_\_\_\_ master with another.
    - This was not a description that Paul used flippantly. He only used it to describe one other man. 1:7
    - Tychicus didn't need a fancy \_\_\_\_\_ or a prominent position. His attitude was, "What do you need done, Paul? I'll do it."
  - He was an \_\_\_\_\_ man "All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you."
    - He knew he could count on Tychicus to give the Colossians a realistic update on Paul's ministry and personal \_\_\_\_\_.
  - He was a \_\_\_\_\_ man "he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts"
    - Paul knew that Tychicus would exercise love and compassion towards these believers and be concerned for them.
    - Every believer should desire to be a Tychicus. What a beautiful balance of dependability and honesty, yet \_\_\_\_\_ and compassionate. Ephesians 4:15
