		The fruit of the Spirit deals with attitude and character, while
		spiritual gifts are concerned with ministry.
	B.	Second, we do not receive spiritual gifts as we in Christ.
	C.	Third, spiritual gifts are not to be confused with talents.
	D.	Fourth, a spiritual gift is not a specialty of ministry.
