- Here we see the apostle Paul facing the end of his life. He describes the end as...
  - ⇒ A poured-out offering.
  - ⇒ A ship leaving the moorings of a port.
- He views his life in the present as coming to a close, in the past as a course that has been finished, and in the future as a crown to be won.
- We will all one day come to the end of our earthly existence, and in that day, it is only what has been done in Christ that will last. It is only what has been done in His name that will have lasting value to those we leave behind.
