

# What Does It Take To Lead Others To Jesus?

- Did you know that God could use you to bring other people to Jesus Christ?
- What exactly does it take to lead others to Jesus Christ?

**First, it takes a person who is \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 3**

- Paul knew who Jesus was and wasn't afraid to proclaim it. 1 Thessalonians 2:2
- You may be thinking, "I could never be bold for Christ that way." This is why God \_\_\_\_\_ you the Spirit of Christ.
- *"And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness."* **Acts 4:31**

**Second, it takes a person who is \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 2**

- The Bible states that Paul *"reasoned with them out of the Scriptures."* vs. 2
- Paul brought forth \_\_\_\_\_ from the Scripture to support his teaching.
- Could you prove to someone from the Scriptures what you believe about Jesus Christ?

**Third, it takes a person who is \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 4**

- It was apparent that Paul really cared about these people and their eternal souls. 1 Thessalonians 2:7-8, 11
- *“And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.”*  
**Jude 22-23**

**Fourth, it takes a person who is \_\_\_\_\_.  
1 Thessalonians 2:9**

- What can we do to sacrifice some of our time or resources in order to be a testimony to someone else?

**Fifth, it takes someone who is \_\_\_\_\_.  
1 Thessalonians 1:5, 2:10**

- The Thessalonians were watching Paul's life to see if his walk matched his talk. 1 Thessalonians 1:5, 2:10

**Sixth, it takes a person who is not easily deterred  
by \_\_\_\_\_. vs. 5-10**

- Paul mentioned how he was shamefully entreated at Philippi, yet spake the gospel boldly in Thessalonica. 1 Thessalonians 2:2
- In Thessalonica the criticism started up again. vs. 5
- Paul would leave town, but his converts and this newly formed church \_\_\_\_\_!
